Please complete the registration form. All registration forms must be received before April 12.

Friday, April 15: We will meet at 8:00 a.m. (sharp) at the Jeanerette City Park:

Directions to Jeanerette City Park coming from U.S. Hwy 90:

From Hwy. 90 take the Jeanerette exit (LA 668) which will turn into LA 671 at the caution light. LA 671 will take you to Main Street/LA 182 in Jeanerette where you will take a left. After the second traffic light on Main Street take a right onto Wormser Street then a left onto Tarleton. This will take you to the boat ramp.

Saturday, April 16: We will meet at 8:00 a.m. (sharp) at the Baldwin City Park.

Directions to Baldwin City Park coming from Hwy 90:

From Hwy. 90 take the Baldwin exit (LA 83) to LA182. Take a right onto LA182 then a left at the first traffic light onto Charenton Rd. (LA326). The Baldwin City Park will be on the right side about .25 miles from the traffic light.

Sunday, April 17: We will meet at 8 a.m. at the Roseville Boat Landing in Franklin.

Directions to Roseville Boat Landing from Hwy 90:

From Hwy 90 take the Franklin exit (LA3211) to LA182. Take a right onto LA 182/ Main Street Franklin. The road will curve to your right at the grave yard on Main Street. Take a left onto Roseville. The boat landing is behind the graveyard.
